## RIDING THE ROADSH

Simple tips to follow when riding or driving your horse along NJ's roads:

Ride in the same direction as cars are going. by law, cars must slow down to at least 25 mph

Always wear
An ASTM/SEI
Certified
riding
HELMET

from slipping through the stirrup.

Aboot with a good heel is a must to keep your foot

Use a hand signal or other form of signal to have cars coming in the opposite direction stop 'til you safely pass

Keep dogs and small children away from your horse. A horse can get easily startled by the antics of dogs.

Small children must be watched carefully.







Bright colored clothing or an orange pinney or safety vest lets drivers see you coming. Don't wear loose or bagging clothing.
